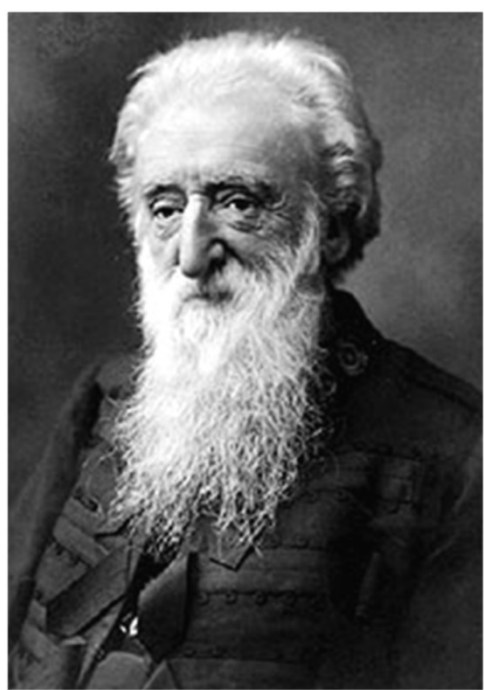
*⁸[Him] If you do not know, O fairest among women **Follow in the footsteps of the flock ...**

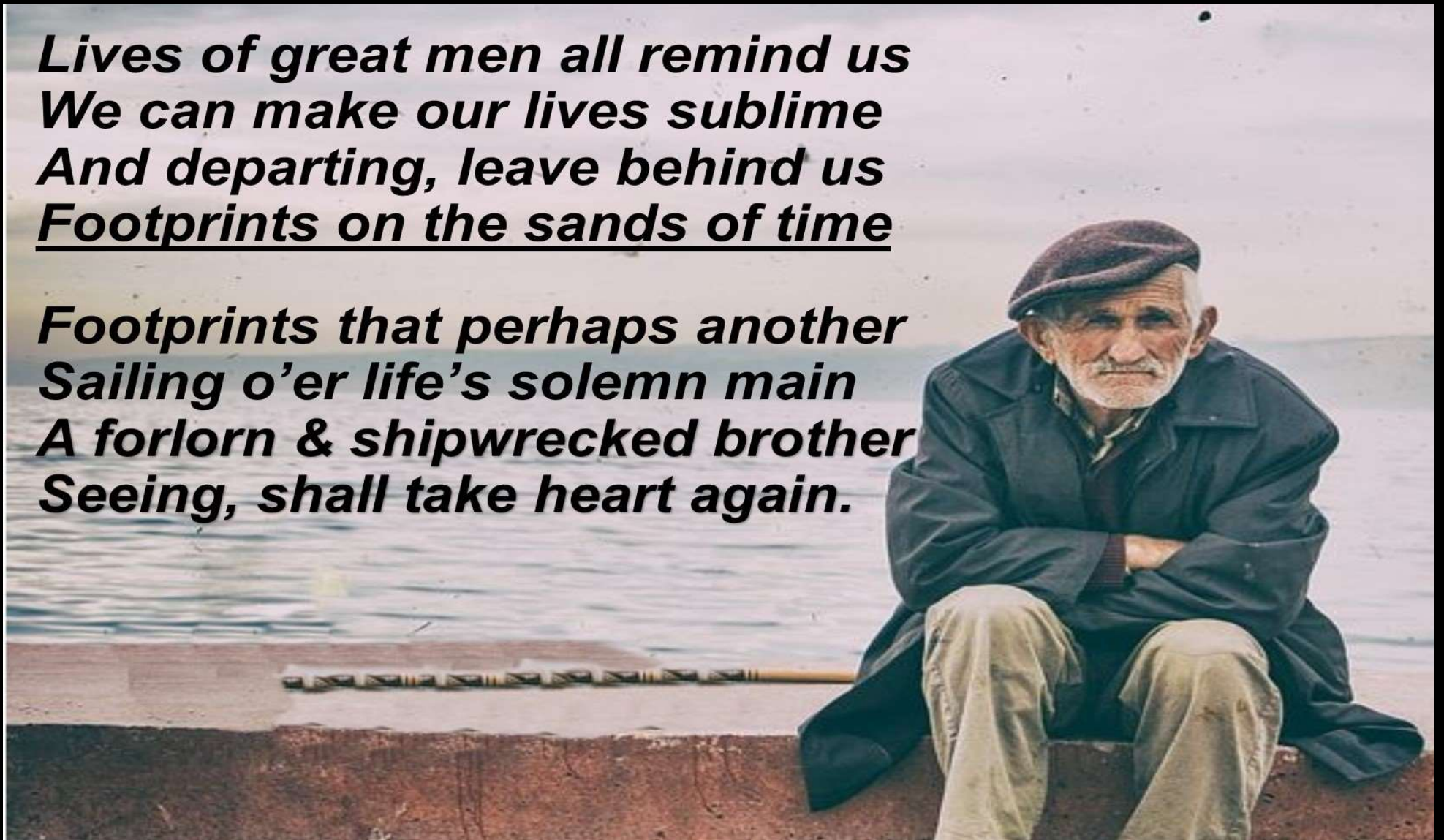
